BABAL Bahrain

located at the entrance to Manama Souq in Bahrain's capital, is a restored cultural landmark. Built in 1949, it once housed administrative offices and overlooked the sea. Today, it houses tourism offices and a visitor's center. Behind Bab Al Bahrain lies the vibrant Manama Souq, a traditional market offering a wide range of goods -from textiles and spices to handicrafts and modern products. PEARLING path

In 2012, "Pearling, Testimony of an Island Economy" became Bahrain's second UNESCO World Heritage Site, recognizing its millennia-old pearl collecting tradition and the globally significant single-product island economy and social system it produced. The serial nomination consists of 15 components: three oyster beds in Bahrain's northern waters, one seashore site in Muharraq, and nine clusters of historic buildings in Muharraq city. Together, these sites reflect the final expression and last remaining example of a cultural tradition that

dominated the Arabian Gulf for centuries, pearling path is (41.0)km close to Raffles Al Areen Palace Bahrain.













JARADA island

Jaradalsland, located 40 minutes from the Bahrain mainland, is a magical destination. BAHRAIN national MUSEUM

Considered one of the Kingdom's cultural landmarks, the Bahrain National Museum, was officially inaugurated by the late Amir H.H. Sheikh Isa Bin Salman Al-Khalifa on 15th December 1988

and was considered one of the finest museums of its kind in the Gulf region. The museum is an emblem of Bahrain's 6000 years of history and the country's story comes to life in the different rooms, halls, and exhibits. The building stands out due to its distinct architecture and white travertine marble facade and stands atop an artificial peninsula overlying the island of Muharraq, the Bahrain national museum is (39.7)km close to Raffles Al Areen Palace Bahrain.














BAHRAIN Fort

Known as al Qalatal-Bahrain, Bahrain Fort is one of many of Bahrain's inscribed UNESCO World Heritage Sites.
